- A. **Consideration of Resolution No. 25/26-54** Approving the City of Wyoming to donate \$_____ to support the Stark County Lady Rebels Basketball -2026 Summer Excellence Campaign. They are seeking to attend the 14th annual Shootout in Wisconsin Dells.
- B. **Consideration of Resolution No. 25/26-55** Authorizing the City of Wyoming to Donate \$_____ to the Stark County Fall Festival Committee. The City will pay the Library District a one-time lump sum of \$17,632.50 from the TIF fund for improvements to the Library building including brick tuckpointing and window replacement.
