Consideration of Resolution No. 26/27-13 Authorizing the City of Wyoming to donate the sum of \$1,000.00 to the 2026 St. Jude Run from Kewanee to Peoria to help support the great work they do for the Children of St. Jude. **The motion was made by Ald. Lindahl to approve Resolution 26/27-13 and seconded by Ald. Hansard. Roll call vote all (5) ayes by Ald. Conover, Ald. Owens, Ald. Lindahl, Ald. Hardman, Ald. Hansard and the motion passed.**

Ald. Hardman informed the Council that last year's Fall Festival had problems with people paying with credit cards. Part of the reason being they didn't know the website password. Most people pay by credit card and aps on their phone. Ald. Owens suggested changing the password just for the weekend of Fall Festival and post it with all the businesses there.
